The Library may include in the collection items by local authors that are self-published or published in a nontraditional manner if they meet a majority of the requirements below and are approved by the librarian in charge of that collection:

1. Published by a vetted/established publisher.
2. Professionally edited: editing was paid for and editor is named.
3. Guaranteed AI free in both words, ideas and illustrations.
4. Item is reviewed by a vetted source.
5. Item is held by another library in our network.
6. Item for review is donated to the Library. The library does not have to purchase the item.

The ultimate decision remains with the Librarian educated and experienced in the specific collection as well as the Library Director.
