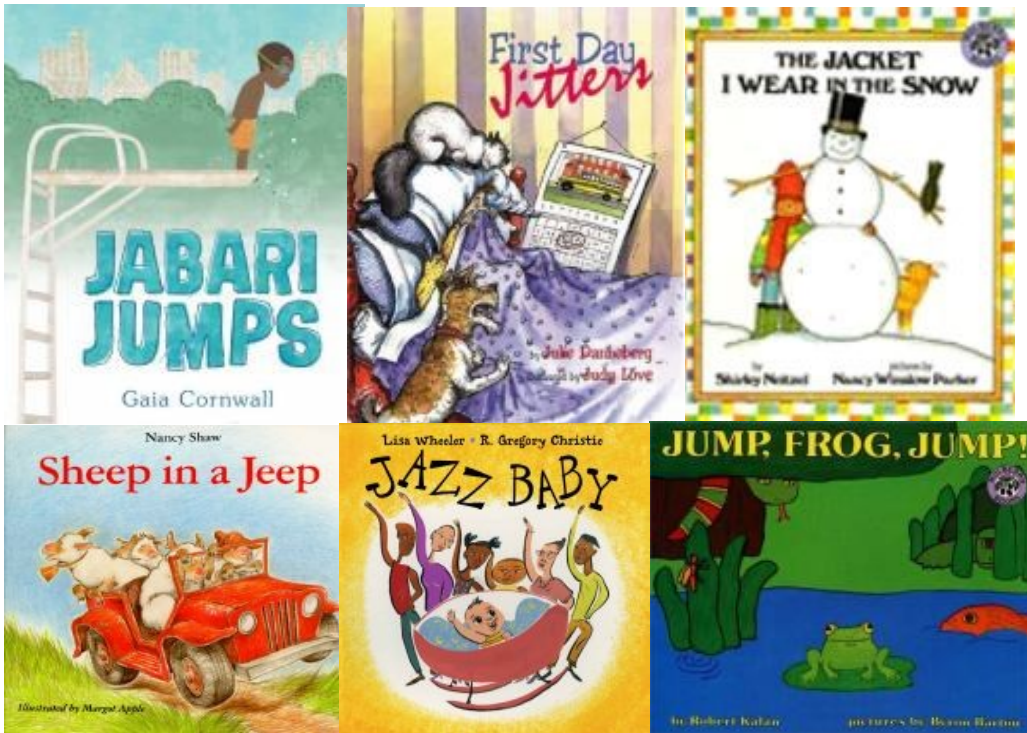


Story Time: The Letter Jj

Activities with the Letter J

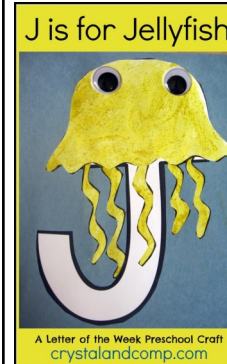
Letter J Collage
